If one or two stand in the way of consensus, we will work to adjust our plans to move forward by incorporating their ideas. However, we will allow something to go forward without their backing if the majority of the group feels strongly that we should move forward.”*

The group wants to keep our basic framework, but encourage the generation of ideas/support for action by forming an “action” subcommittee. Those PRTI members currently engaged in the “guiding direction/guiding document” committee will meet to discuss how such an action committee might operate and what its relationship to the PRTI steering committee might be.
